WHAT ELSE SHOULD I KNOW?

To join the PDAC, you must first complete an application and submit to a criminal background check. A criminal history does not necessarily preclude you from joining the PDAC. However, applicants with a criminal history must receive an exception from the Captain in order to join the PDAC.

The PDAC generally meets one time per month.

Some PDAC groups require you to pay dues.

Membership in PDAC is **strictly voluntary**.
